

## PubMed ID(PMID)-list

Applicants need to deliver a PubMed ID (PMID) list with an application. The listing is made in the PubMed database (<http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed>).

Based on this list selector board will possibly make supplementary citation analyses.

1. In PubMed-database > Search with the author name.
  - a. Search Surname F\* often works.
  - b. You can search on Author field like this: " Surname F"[Author].
2. Select publications where the applicant in an author. Transfer these to the Clipboard. (Send to > Clipboard > Add to Clipboard)

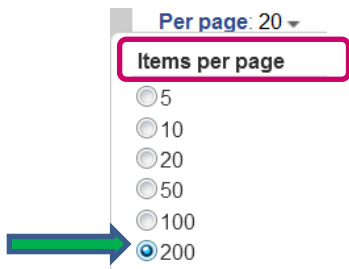

3. Check if all applicant's publications are on the Clipboard. Compare with the publication list. (Clipboard can be found on the upper right side on page.)

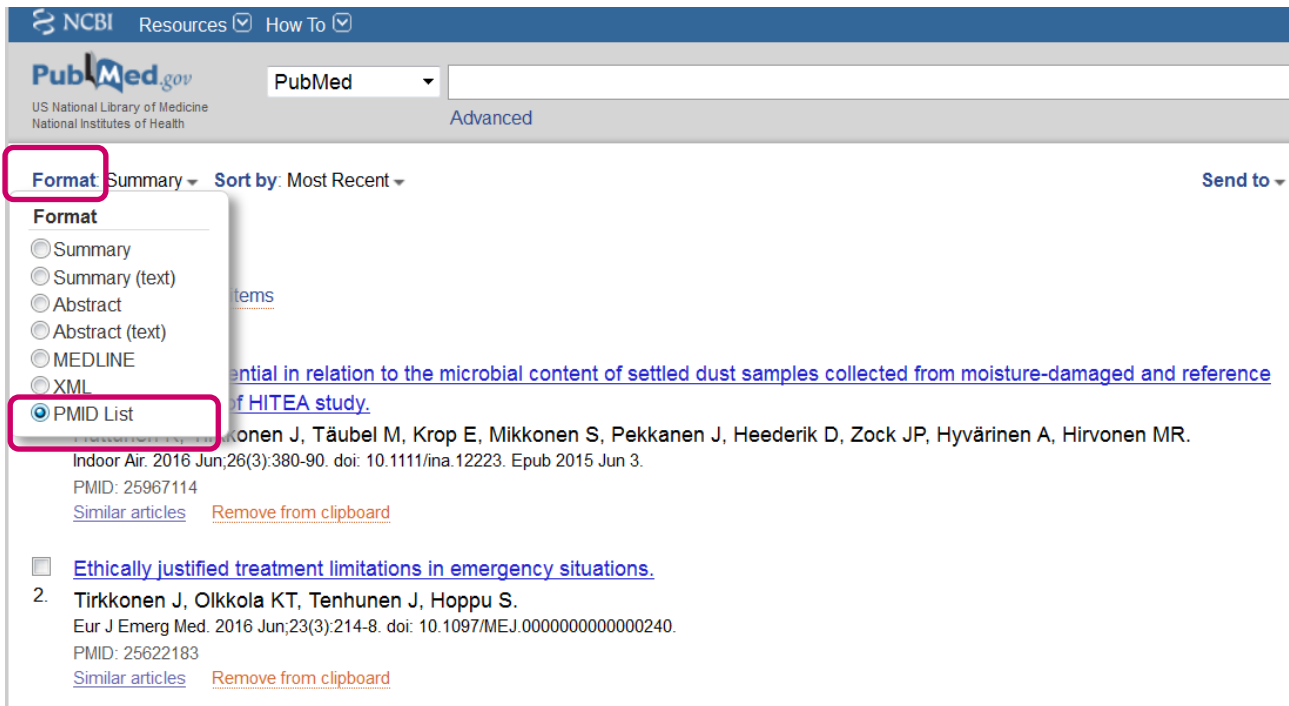

5. When all applicant's publications are on the Clipboard:

- c. Select Format > PMID List .



6. The database produces a PMID-list. Paste this list to application part J.
